Add to pancake mix. Add to chili. Add to any soup. Roast and eat the seeds.

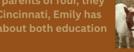

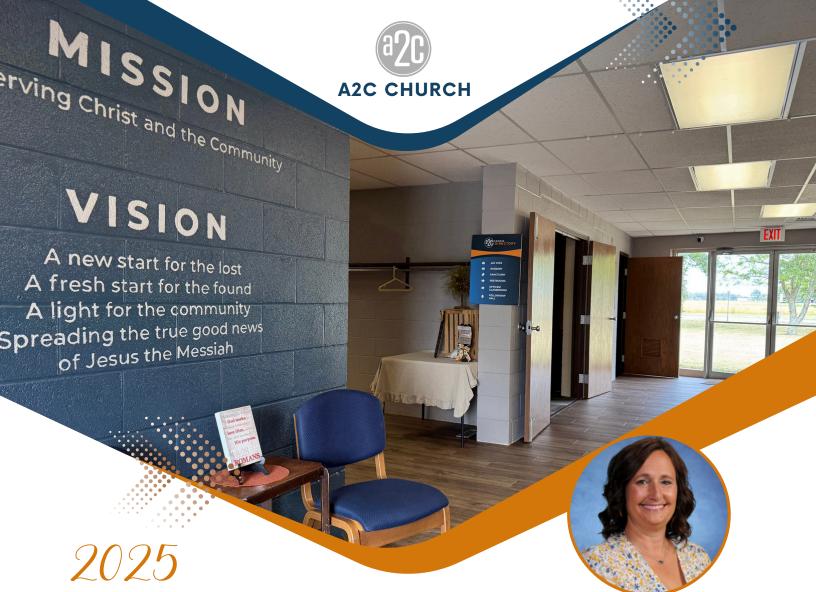

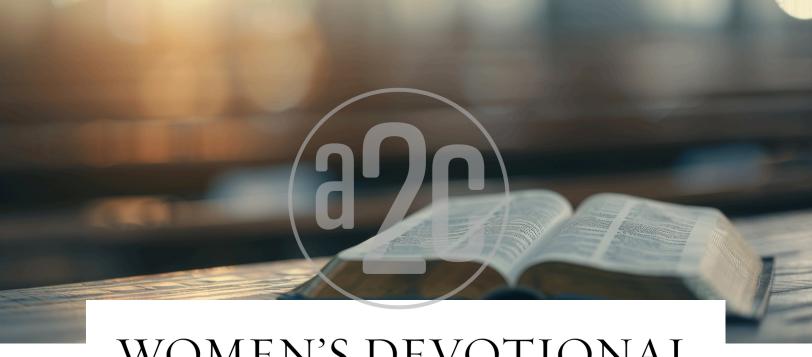
